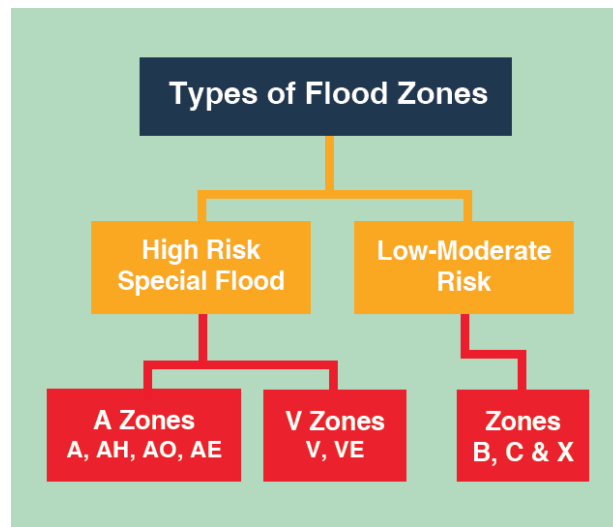




KNOW YOUR FLOOD RISK

Know Your Zone - South Carolina Emergency Management Division’s Know Your Zone program informs citizens of their storm surge vulnerability and the best ways to prepare for a major hurricane. Seabrook Island is in **ZONE A** of Charleston County.



ZONE A: West of the Ashley River - Unincorporated areas of Charleston County from the Ashley River to the Colleton County line; Atlantic Ocean to the Dorchester County Line. This includes City of Folly Beach, Town of Hollywood, Town of Kiawah Island, Town of Meggett, Town of Ravenel, Town of Rockville, Town of the Town of Seabrook Island, James Island, Johns Island, Wadmalaw Island, Adams Run, Parkers Ferry, Wiltown, Yonges Island and all other unincorporated Charleston County in this area.

In preparation for hurricane season and prior to any major hurricane, Seabrookers should be familiar with their evacuation route. South Carolina Department of Transportation has created an interactive evacuation route map. It can be found [here](#).

Seabrook Island evacuees will take US 17 South to SC 64 where they will go to Walterboro, then to Aiken and I-20.
